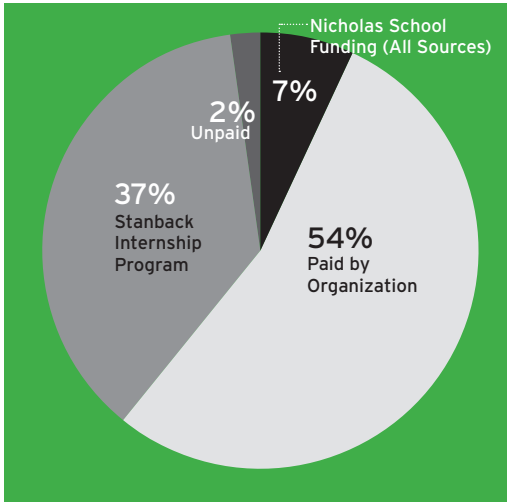


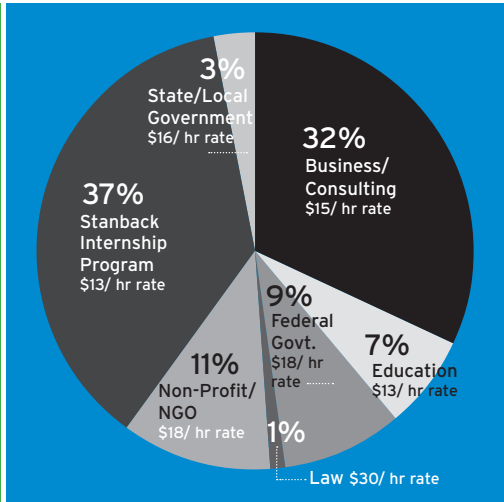
2015 NICHOLAS SCHOOL OF THE ENVIRONMENT AT DUKE UNIVERSITY INTERNSHIP PROFILE

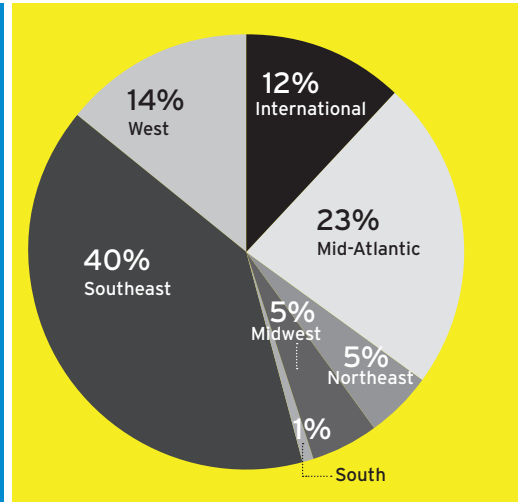
FUNDING SOURCE

Notables:

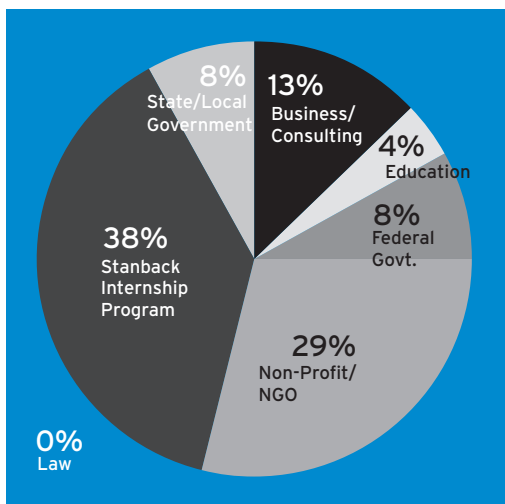
- The Ecotoxicology and Environmental Health Concentration had the highest average hourly rate at \$18/hr.
- All other concentrations were between \$11/hr. to \$15/hr.
- All, but 3 internships were funded.
- EDF Climate Corps hired and placed 9 MEM students.
- 79% of the international students who reported having a summer internship or project secured positions in the US.

2015 INTERNSHIP PROFILE BY CONCENTRATION

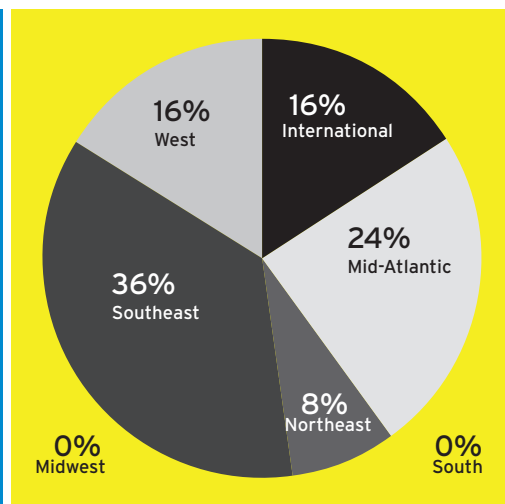

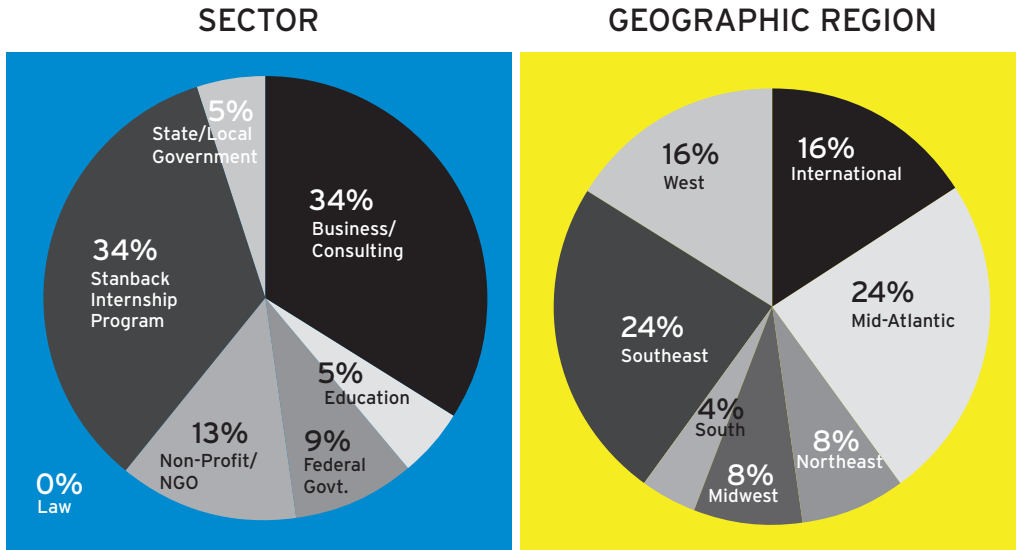


GEOGRAPHIC REGION

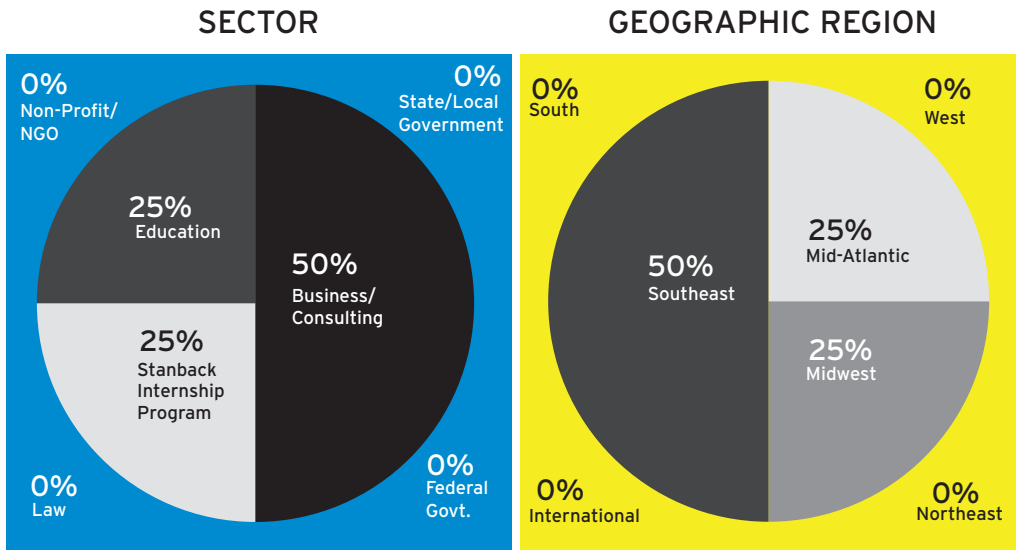

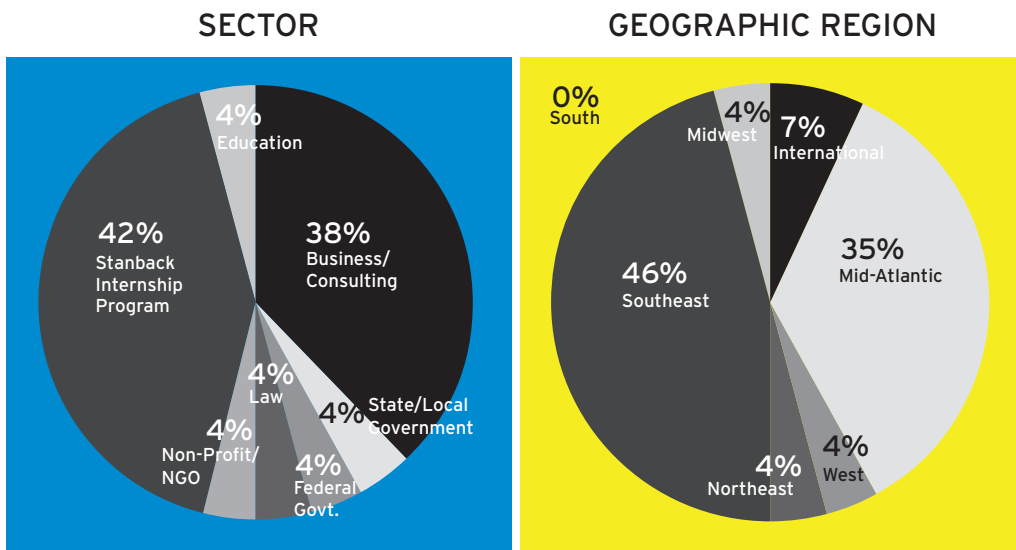
Energy and Environment (EE) Concentration



Ecotoxicology and Environmental Health (EEH) Concentration

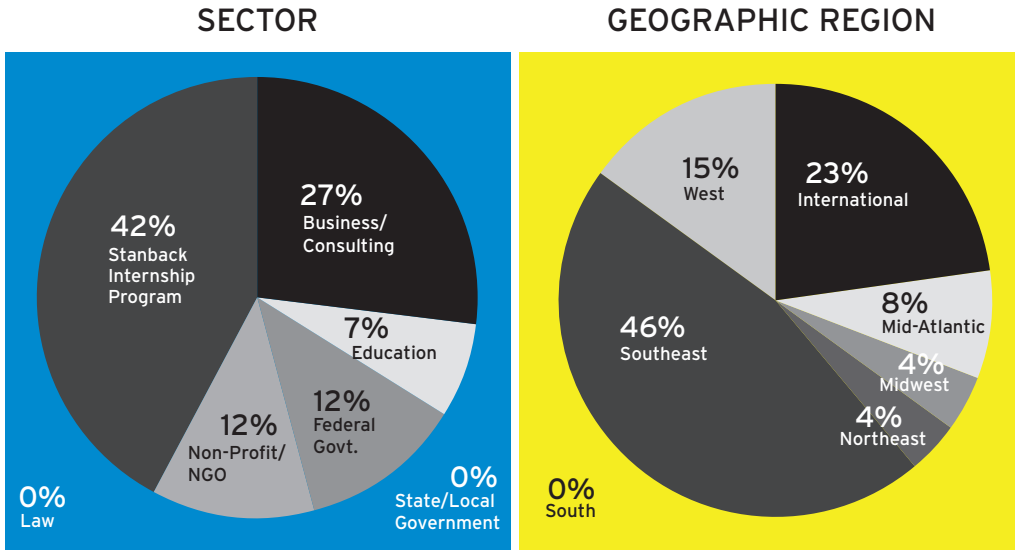


Environmental Economics and Policy (EEP) Concentration

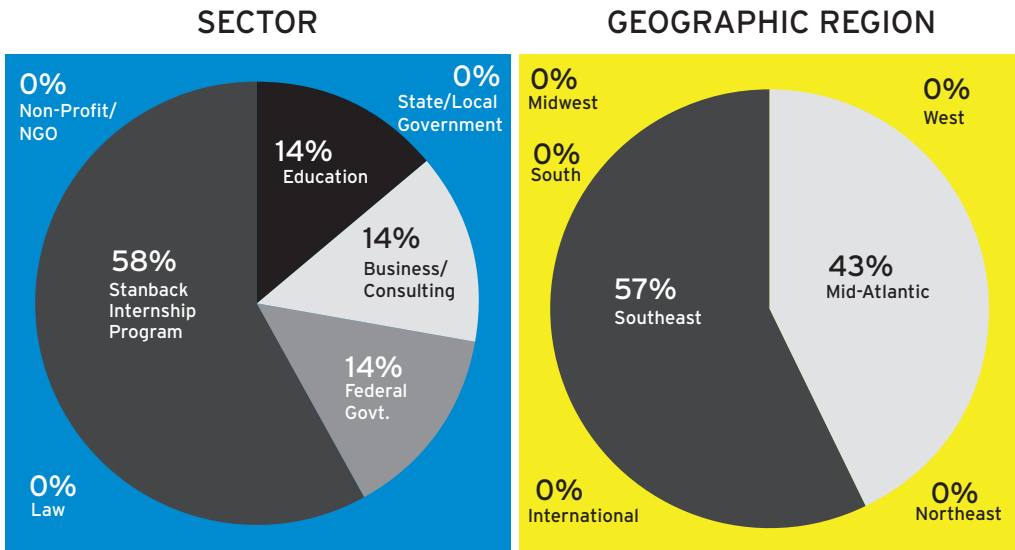

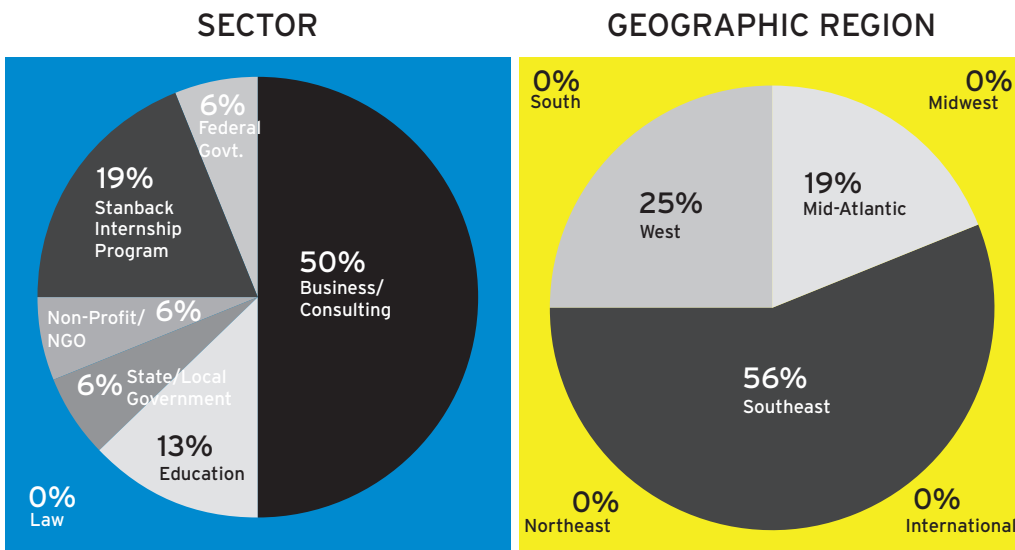
Ecosystem Science and Conservation (ESC) Concentration
